

- Compile Holidays Homework in a decorative folder.




### **STEPS involved**

- 7. Share the video of your recording with your class teacher on her personal number.**



# ART

1. Draw a Rainy Day Scene on A4 size sheet.
2. Make a Paper Plate Butterfly and Sunflower with Tissue Paper as given in the pictures below.

### Paper Plate Butterfly



**1. Paint the Paper Plate :**  
Roughly make a curvy centre line which divides the paper plate into two halves. Now, paint the top side of the paper plate using whatever colours and designs you like. Designs should be identical on both sides of the line. This will be the butterfly's wings.



**2. Paint the Toilet Paper Roll :**  
The toilet paper roll will be the butterfly's body. Paint it black or whatever colour you like.



**3. Cut the Paper Plate :**  
Cut the paper plate in half from the line drawn earlier to make the butterfly's wings.

**Materials Needed :**

- \* Paper Plate
- \* Toilet Paper Roll
- \* Paint
- \* Googly Eyes
- \* Thick woollen thread
- \* Craft Glue
- \* Paint Brush
- \* Scissors



**4. Glue on the Wings :**  
Glue the wings onto the toilet paper roll as shown in the picture.



**5. Make the Antenna :**  
Cut two pieces of thick woollen thread, about two inches long. Harden it by dipping in the glue solution and then dry it.



**6. Add the Eyes :**  
Glue the two googly eyes onto the toilet paper roll.



**7. Finishing the Butterfly :**  
Finally, glue the woollen thread antenna just above the eyes. Now, your butterfly is ready. Display it on a table or attach it to a piece of string and hang it.



**Materials Needed :**

- \* Brown card paper
- \* Green straw
- \* Yellow and green tissue paper
- \* Pencil
- \* Scissors
- \* Glue
- \* Tape




**1. Cut an 8 cm diameter circle from a dark brown card paper.**



**2. Fold three 16 cm squares of yellow tissue paper in half twice, to form layers of 8 cm squares.**



**3. Draw petals as shown above and cut out the flower shape from the open sides. Do not cut along the folded edges.**



**4. Open out flat all the pieces of tissue paper. You will get 3 flower shapes.**



**5. Glue the 3 tissue paper flowers to the back of the brown circle, staggering the petals to create the sunflower as shown.**



**6. Tape a drinking straw to the back of the sunflower to form the stem. Cut out the leaves from a green tissue paper and add as shown. Now your sunflower is ready.**
