

(Past Adjustment/Opening capital missing and interest on apital and drawings omitted) Mohan, Vijay and Anil are equal partners, the balances in their capital accounts being ₹ 30,000, ₹ 25,000 and ₹ 20,000 respectively. In arriving at these igures, the profits for the year ended March 31, 2017, ₹ 24,000 had already been credited to partners in the proportion in which they share profits. Their drawings were Mohan ₹ 5,000, tiply ₹ 4,000 and Anil ₹ 3,000. Subsequently, the following omissions were noticed and it was iscided to bring them into account:

- (i) Interest on Capital at 10% per annum.
- (ii) Interest on Drawings was : Mohan ₹ 250, Vijay ₹ 200 and Anil ₹ 150.
